



General Conditions of the Pilar Ferrer de Sant Jordi Award

(Approved by the Board of the Faculty on 4th November 2015)

The Pilar Ferrer de Sant Jordi Award is presented every year and was created to acknowledge the best Final Degree Project (TFG) in each academic year of the Degree in Nursing and Degree in Physiotherapy. The award has no economic reward but offers curricular accreditation for students.

Participants

All students on both degrees who have publically defended their TFG before a panel may take part, both in the ordinary deadline (June) and in the deadline established for students who have applied for early assessment.

Assessment Process

- One award for each degree shall be granted.
- The award will go to the TFG with the best final mark. If there is a tie between marks, innovation and knowledge transfer criteria shall be taken into account.
- In the event of a draw, the award jury shall comprise the lecturers from the viva panels for the corresponding academic year. Lecturers who having been on tribunals have also been tutors for any of the candidate projects shall recuse themselves from the jury.
- The jury members shall designate a spokesperson. The jury spokesperson shall, within ten calendar days at the latest, notify the heads of the subject regarding the name of the winning student ten calendar days after the June viva panels are held.
- The decision of the jury shall be officially notified to the award winners. In turn, this decision shall be announced at the following Board of the Faculty meeting.
- The award shall be handed out at the closing ceremony of the corresponding academic year.
